## 37. Champagne Palmer & Co Blanc de Blancs Brut NV

*One for Champagne aficionados recently been crowned "World Champion" for their Blanc de Blancs at the Champagne & Sparkling Wine World Championships. Tom Stevenson rates this house as one of the Top 5 most underrated Champagnes'.*

## 38. Taittinger Prestige Brut Rosé NV

- 52. Villa Dei Fiori Primitivo, Puglia 2018/9 (S)** Italy £22.50  
*Primitivo is Puglia's answer to Zinfandel and means early ripening, the resulting wines are big, luscious and full of fruit. Bottled sunshine!*
- 53. Caruso Minini Frappato, Sicilia 2018** Italy £22.95  
*The wine has flavours of red fruits, summer herbs and a touch of violet. It's rich and jammy, yet refreshing. We recommend you enjoy this wine slightly chilled.*
- 54. Moonseng Merlot Manseng Noir, Côtes de Gascogne 2018** France £24.95  
*Plaimont revived a forgotten grape variety of the Tannat family, the Manseng Noir and paired it with luscious Merlot to create a unique blend that is a silky-smooth.*
- 55. La Traca Tinto Bobal Bodega Mustguillo, Valencia 2019** Spain £26.95  
*A clean and bright, expressive wine with lots of red and black fruit and spicy touches. It's bright and pure with a lovely minerality backing up the plush red fruit.*
- 56. Les Cotilles Pinot Noir Vin de France Roux 2019** France £27.95  
*Lively and structured, with a well-rounded and supple backbone. Tannins and fruit go hand in hand and match the power of the secondary aromas. This wine has volume and flesh.*
- 57. Xanadu Exmoor Cabernet Sauvignon, Margaret River 2018** Australia £32.95  
*Multi award winner A generous full bodied wine full of inky forest fruits. Properly good value wine, rich and satisfying, having a steak?...drink this!*
- 58. Journey's End Huntsman Shiraz, Stellenbosch 2018**  South Africa £33.95  
*A very approachable style of Shiraz, with soft fruits and an underlying edge of spiciness with chocolate and violets! Great on its own or with pie!*
- 59. St Cosme Cotes du Rhone Rouge, 2019 (O)** France £34.95  
*Without doubt one of the very best producers in France, let alone the Southern Rhone, with winemaker Louis Barruol crafting terroir-specific wines. Floral, lilac aromas, wild strawberries and some herbal complexity underneath.*

*Catena pretty much invented making quality Malbec. Taking what was a fairly common poorly used grape and taking it to new heights of sophistication and class. Beautifully structured, soft tannins, dark mulberry fruit flavours*
- 61. Bhilar Plots Tinto Rioja, Alavesa 2019** Spain £38.95  
*Rioja Alavesa is a small, boutique winery situated in Elvillar. It's Bhilar Plots Rioja is rich and dark, with black fruit, blueberry, strawberry, cherry and black pepper. Beautifully structured with fine-grade tannins and refreshing acidity.*
- 62. Some Young Punks Naked on Roller Skates Shiraz Mataro 2019** Australia £38.95  
*With their punk attitude to winemaking, this wine has charisma and attitude. Expressive musk and violet with dense black fruits, a little quince and juniper spice.*
- 63. Charles Smith Velvet Devil Merlot, Washington State 2017**  USA £42.95  
*If Merlot is the "vanilla ice cream" of red wines, then this is Ben & Jerry's Vanilla Caramel Fudge. Self-indulgent, decadent, lush and oh so good!*
- 64. La Dama Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore Classico, Veneto 2017**  Italy £44.50
